

Workshop Application Update

I am pleased to bring you news of the latest update to the Workshop Web Application.

The release deployed on the evening of 2nd June included the following items:

Autodata updates dashboard (English only) – So our users get a more insight into the constant evolution, maintenance and additions to our service we have added an update dashboard to the home page. This details the number of vehicle or content updates (this includes new vehicles and updates to existing content) and also the number of application enhancements and bug fixes we have released. When we have the translations complete this content will be added for all other supported languages.

Translated corporate videos – Following on from the English version we now include the Italian, French, German and Australian corporate videos on the home page for users with the relevant language preference.

Seamless user session re-set improvements – Now when using the session re-set functionality, seamless login users no longer see the 'Username' and 'Password' boxes.

Action description added to parts on Service Guide and Estimate Calculator – So users can more easily identify parts and fluids that need replacing or simply 'topping-up' we now include the action description alongside the parts on the service guide and estimate calculator.

Support page for New Zealand users – Technicians in New Zealand can now access the same support contact page as Australia so they know how to get in touch when they need assistance.

Local date now displayed on Service and Estimate printouts – Particularly relevant for Australian and New Zealand users, the date on the user machine is now used on the service and estimate printouts rather than that of our UK based servers.

6 additional small bug fixes and enhancements – More bugs fixed to improve reliability and user experience.


