

## Workshop Application Update

I am pleased to bring you news of the latest update to the Workshop Web Application.

The release deployed on the evening of 21<sup>st</sup> May included the following items:

**Wiring diagram key added to wiring diagram print** – The colour code key is now included on the wiring diagram print out so users now decipher the wire colours when printing black and white diagrams.

**Titles added to interactive diagrams** – We now display the title and variant information on the wiring diagrams, component location diagrams, engine bays and fuse box/relay plates.

**Garage ID shown under settings icon** – To assist the customer facing teams and help them locate the garage account the garage ID is now displayed under the username on the settings drop down.

**Translation update** – The latest translation update has been completed to ensure that all the latest application text is displayed in the correct user language.

**New icon and job folder tweaks** – We have added a new 'back to all technical information' icon and added a slight design improvement to the job folder to make it more obvious that more information is available.

**German and Spanish page specific Youtube videos** – Extending the language support for the page specific Youtube videos these are now available in Spanish and German.

**New login page image** – In support of the Autopromotec show in Italy we've added an Alpha Romeo to the login page.

**10 additional small bug fixes and enhancements** – More bugs fixed to improve reliability and user experience.

## Wiring diagram key added to wiring diagram print

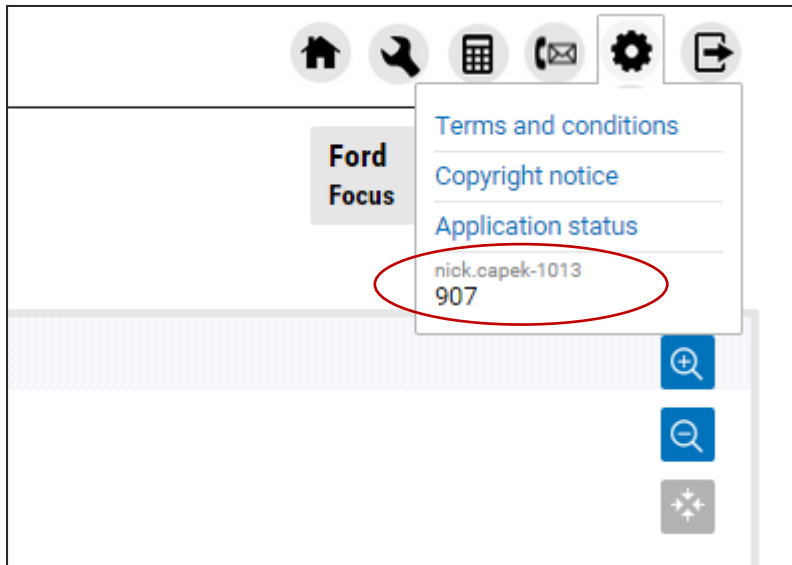
bl = blue	br = brown	el = cream	ge = yellow
gn = green	gr = grey	nl = neutral	og = orange
rs = pink	rl = red	sw = black	vi = violet
ws = white	hbl = light blue	hgn = light green	rbr = maroon
x = braided cable	y = high tension	z = non-cable connection	

NOTE: In certain diagrams (Citroen, Peugeot & Renault), colour codes are replaced by numbers which are used to identify a particular cable and not the colour. In this instance, the cables will be numbered at each end close to the harness connector.

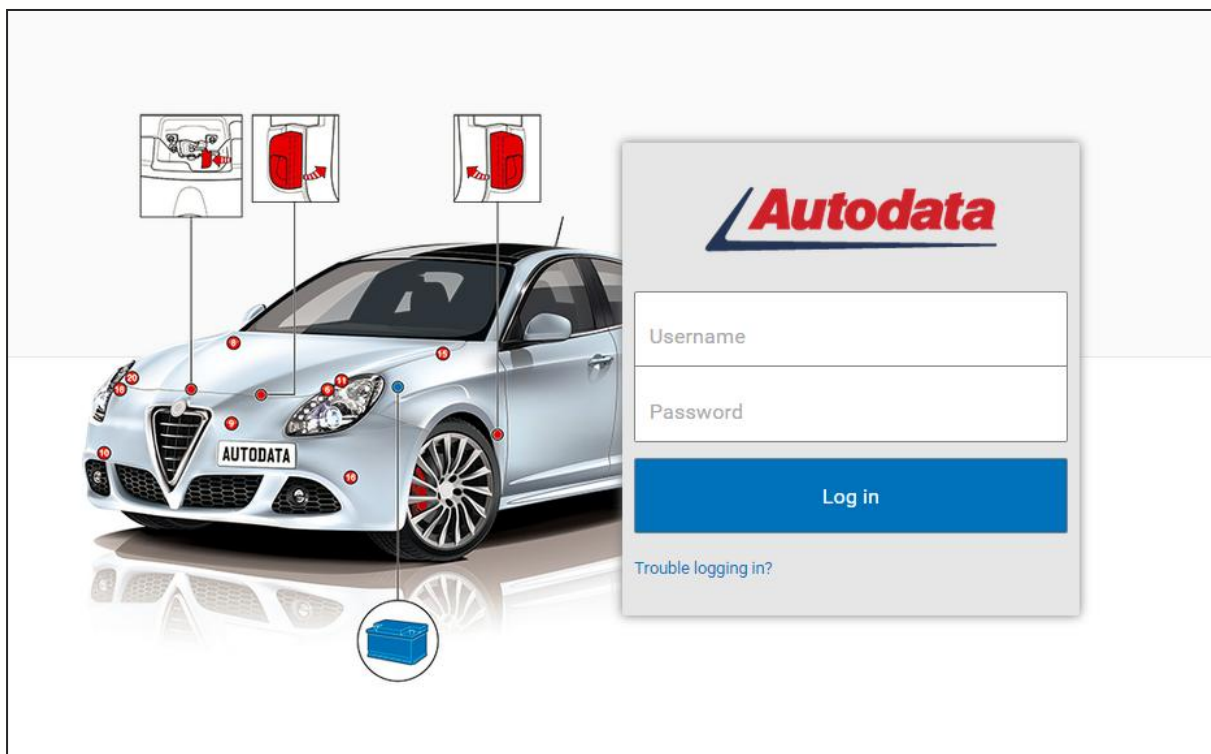
